Children encounter pesticides everyday and are uniquely vulnerable to their toxicity. Prenatal and early childhood exposure to pesticide is associated with *pediatric cancers, decreased cognitive function, and behavioral problems*. Americans use more than a billion pounds of pesticide each year on farm crops and lawns, in homes, schools, parks, hospitals and public spaces.
